Achieving the Best Performance

To achieve the best performance:

- Use only good quality connection cables (we recommend Kramer high-performance, high-resolution cables) to avoid interference, deterioration in signal quality due to poor matching, and elevated noise levels (often associated with low quality cables)
- Do not secure the cables in tight bundles or roll the slack into tight coils
- Avoid interference from neighboring electrical appliances that may adversely influence signal quality
- Position your Kramer UTBUS-2xI away from moisture, excessive sunlight and dust

This equipment is to be used only inside a building. It may only be connected to other equipment that is installed inside a building.



There are no operator serviceable parts inside the unit.

Universal socket The Universal socket fits almost all power cords, worldwide

Insert The insert is fitted in the inner frame. Go to our Web site to check for a variety of single and dual sized inserts

Overview

The **UTBUS-2xI** is a furniture-mounted connection bus that is easily installed underneath a wooden table or podium top. The unit is sturdy, cost-effective, and easy to install.


The UTBUS-2xI:

- Is modular in design, letting you install up to six wall plate inserts, according to your requirements.
- Has a dual power socket opening that is suitable for any of the following power sockets: for the USA, Germany (the Europlug), Belgium-France, Italy, Australia, Israel, Switzerland, UK, South Africa or "Universal" for use anywhere (see compatibility restrictions in <u>Technical Specifications of the Assembled UTBUS-2xl</u> on page <u>8</u>).

Power sockets are ordered separately.

Defining the UTBUS-2xl Enclosure






Figure 2: UTBUS-2xl Under the Table Connection Bus

#	Feature	Function
1	Blank Plates	Six blank covers that can be replaced with wall plate inserts as required (see Installing the Required Wall Plate Inserts on page 6).
2	Power Socket Opening	Suitable for international power requirements (Suitable for international power requirements (available with different types of power sockets, ordered separately, see <u>Power Socket Options</u> on page <u>5</u>).
3	Outer Rim	For mounting under the table.
4	Tie Holes (12)	Insert self-locking ties through the holes to fix the pass-through cables to the inside walls of the UTBUS-2xI.
5	Rim Screw Holes (4)	For fixing the UTBUS-2xI under the table (including two open screw holes).



Installing the Required Wall Plate Inserts


By default, the mounting surface includes a power socket opening and four blank plates for optional video, audio and network connectors. Each blank plate can be removed and replaced with a Kramer passive wall plate insert or connector module for interfacing A/V type signals, if required. To install a wall-plate insert or connector module, do the following:


1. Unscrew the two screws that attach the blank plate to the connecting surface and remove the blank plate (save the two screws).



2. Place the required wall plate insert item over the opening.

3. Reinsert the two screws to affix the wall plate insert in position and tighten them.






Installing the Power Sockets

To install the power socket:

 Insert the modular power socket in its place (in this example, a universal power socket is shown, but you can use any of the available power sockets, see <u>Power Socket Options</u> on page <u>5</u>). 2. Tighten the two screws (supplied with the power socket module). The power socket is now installed.



Installing the Cables

To install the cables, do the following:

- 1. Connect the cables to the inside of the unit.
- 2. Insert the self-locking ties through the tie holes to secure the cables to the inside walls of the enclosure.

Securing the UTBUS-2xl Enclosure to the Table




Figure 4: Securing the UTBUS-2xI Under the Table

To install the **UTBUS-2xI** underneath the table, as illustrated in Figure 4, do the following:

- 1. Place the unit to the underside of the table and mark the correct location.
- 2. Insert the four wood screws into the four rim screw holes and fix the **UTBUS-2xI** to the table.

This limited warranty does not cover any damage, deterioration or malfunction resulting from any alteration, modification, improper or unreasonable use or maintenance, misuse, abuse, accident, neglect, exposure to excess moisture, fire, improper packing and shipping (such claims must be presented to the carrier), lightning, power surges, or other acts of nature. This limited warranty does not cover any damage, deterioration or malfunction resulting from the installation or removal of this product from any installation, any unauthorized tampering with this product, any repairs attempted by anyone unauthorized by Kramer Electronics to make such repairs, or any other cause which does not relate directly to a defect in materials and/or workmanship of this product. This limited warranty does not cover any damage, deterioration with this product. Without limiting any other exclusion herein, Kramer Electronics does not warrant that the product covered hereby, including, without limitation, the technology and/or integrated circuit(s) included in the product, will not become obsolete or that such items are or will remain compatible with any other product or technology with which the product may be used.

How Long this Coverage Lasts

The standard limited warranty for Kramer products is seven (7) years from the date of original purchase, with the following exceptions:

- 1. All Kramer VIA hardware products are covered by a standard three (3) year warranty for the VIA hardware and a standard three (3) year warranty for firmware and software updates.
- 2. All Kramer fiber optic cables, adapter-size fiber optic extenders, active cables, cable retractors, all Kramer speakers and Kramer touch panels are covered by a standard one (1) year warranty.
- 3. All Kramer Cobra products, all Kramer Calibre products, all Kramer Minicom digital signage products, all HighSecLabs products, all streaming, and all wireless products are covered by a standard three (3) year warranty.
- 4. All Sierra Video MultiViewers are covered by a standard five (5) year warranty.
- 5. Sierra switchers & control panels are covered by a standard seven (7) year warranty (excluding power supplies and fans that are covered for three (3) years).
- 6. K-Touch software is covered by a standard one (1) year warranty for software updates.
- 7. All Kramer passive cables are covered by a ten (10) year warranty.

Who is Covered

Only the original purchaser of this product is covered under this limited warranty. This limited warranty is not transferable to subsequent purchasers or owners of this product.

What Kramer Electronics Will Do

Kramer Electronics will, at its sole option, provide one of the following three remedies to whatever extent it shall deem necessary to satisfy a proper claim under this limited warranty:

- 1. Elect to repair or facilitate the repair of any defective parts within a reasonable period of time, free of any charge for the necessary parts and labor to complete the repair and restore this product to its proper operating condition. Kramer Electronics will also pay the shipping costs necessary to return this product once the repair is complete.
- 2. Replace this product with a direct replacement or with a similar product deemed by Kramer Electronics to perform substantially the same function as the original product.
- 3. Issue a refund of the original purchase price less depreciation to be determined based on the age of the product at the time remedy is sought under this limited warranty.

You may also be directed to an authorized reseller or a person authorized by Kramer Electronics to repair the product. If it is decided that this product should be returned directly to Kramer Electronics, this product should be properly packed, preferably in the original carton, for shipping. Cartons not bearing a return authorization number will be refused.
